Tour Features and Considerations

Note: This is an active trip that requires walking on uneven surfaces including steps and hills, at times for a mile or two and for 1-2 hours at a time. Concerned about stamina or abilities? Please consult with one of the tour leaders.

PROGRAM FEE OF \$2,300/person includes accommodations in comfortable hotel/guesthouse settings based on double occupancy; breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily except 4 lunches; group transfers between airports and hotels; travel in a comfortable tour bus; sightseeing and entrance fees; tips and taxes; and honoraria to organizations and speakers.

PAYMENT: Deposit of \$500, payable to Meeting Peacemakers, is due with registration to secure your spot in the group. Balance of \$1800 (plus single supplement if not sharing a double room) is due by September 1, 2022. (Credit card + 3%.)

NOT INCLUDED IN TOUR COST: Cost of airfare*, luggage handling at airport and guest houses, single room supplement of \$400, 4 lunches, comprehensive travel/health insurance, beverages with meals, passport fees, excess baggage, items of a personal nature. If participants choose land-only registration, fee does not include airport transfers other than with the group.

COVID VACCINATION NOTE: All participants must provide proof of being fully vaccinated (including available boosters). Given travel uncertainties under COVID, we also require individual purchase of comprehensive travel/health insurance. (If COVID tests are still required in October to re-enter the USA, the cost of a rapid test in Israel will also be the participant's responsibility.)

TO GUARANTEE A SPOT IN THE GROUP, register by August 1, 2022. To offer this group cost, we request deposit and final payment by check. If paying by credit card, registration fee is \$515 and the balance due will be \$1854. Check with Joan Deming for information on credit card payment. *NOTE:* The per person tour costs are based on shared occupancy, land costs and currency valuations as of winter 2022, a minimum group size of 16 and are subject to availability and change.

*FLIGHT RESERVATIONS: Call our travel agent, Joy Harris, to make airline reservations as part of the Meeting Peacemakers group. We will travel on a Delta Airlines group ticket from Seattle (or your nearest large departure airport) to Tel Aviv.

If making your own travel arrangements, we prefer that you still use our travel agent so all arrivals/departures can be coordinated. She will help you plan so that you arrive in Tel Aviv on Oct 13 before 6:00pm, and plan your flight home to leave Tel Aviv just before midnight on Oct 25 or in the wee hours of Oct 26. (Leaving later will require spending a night in the airport or paying extra for private hotel & transportation.)

Travel payment by credit card or check will be made directly to our travel agent: Joy Harris.

COMPREHENSIVE TRAVEL INSURANCE: Proof of Insurance covering health, baggage, and trip cancellation/interruption is required. Joy Harris can provide a reference for purchasing insurance through Allianz, or check with Joan for other options.

PASSPORT, VISA & VACCINATIONS: U.S. citizens need a passport valid at least six months after their date of return to the US. Allow at least 4 months to receive your passport. Get applications at http://www.travel.state.gov/. You will receive your visa at passport control in Tel Aviv. You do not need to apply for it in advance. No vaccinations are required. Non-U.S. citizens are responsible for knowing their own passport and visa requirements; without proper documents entry can be denied at tour member's expense. Provide a photocopy of your passport to the tour leader before by September 1, 2022.

REFUND POLICY: If cancellation is received in writing before Sept 1, 2022, a \$200 fee will be deducted from your refund (plus unrecoverable deposits or air and land service payments). For cancellations received in writing on Sept 1, 2022 or later, a \$500 cancellation fee will be deducted from your refund, due to contracts in place for tour features, commitments to other tour members, and the services rendered on behalf of all tour members. Airline tickets are issued at the time you make your reservation and are nonrefundable. **Insurance refunds must be sought from the insurance provider.**
